### Cimatic trend

The early months of 2019 saw an increase in extreme weather, including short but intense rainfall. Sprouting began in line with vines' natural life cycle, and then slowed down due to a drop in temperature. June, on the other hand, was hot with higher-than-average temperatures. Late summer saw significant stormy weather. September saw the return of sunshine and mild temperatures, which resulted in perfect maturity and quality when it came time to harvest the grapes.

**Organoleptic Notes**  
Leccioni 2019 is a beautiful, bright red wine with purple tinges. The bouquet is rich with fruity and floral aromas. Fruity notes include cherry and redcurrant, as well as darker varieties like blueberry. Its spiciness and balsamic freshness round off the aromatic profile. It is soft and well-rounded on the palate. A simple wine with excellent persistence.

#### match

This wine is fantastic paired with the classic Tuscan antipasto of assorted cured meats. It is equally good with a thick vegetable soup or red meats prepared simply – grilled, for example.
